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Coaching & education

Education is a determining factor of change for the development of any country, therefore, it is of utmost importance that there is a generalised commitment to its improvement. Educational coaching is an innovative concept in the professional area; although the term coaching has been a very useful tool in different disciplines, its recent application in the field of education focuses mainly on getting the best out of students and boosting their performance.

Educational coaching is a methodology that seeks to develop the maximum potential and performance in students, this methodology influences their transformation and changes their perspective, as its objective is to increase their motivation, commitment, responsibility and learning.

The main objective of coaching applied to education is to create the appropriate conditions for students to grow and learn. An important point within this methodology is to be aware that educational coaching is not directive teaching, i.e. the coach is not above the students, but rather an atmosphere of empathy and trust is generated where both parties, coach-teacher and students, are on the same level.

Five principles

- **Students' potential.** More than instructing students, you must be able to find and develop the true potential of each of your students. Often the traditional methodology of education leaves this point as unimportant, however, this is the key to the correct development of the student.
- **Self-awareness.** If you want to get the best out of each of your students, the first step to achieve this is through self-awareness.
- **Empowerment.** One of the most important points in coaching applied to education is the teacher's ability to empower students and make them more independent, you should not educate them from knowledge, but from the responsibility and importance that this knowledge implies.
- **Development of competencies.** In order to apply the methodology of educational coaching, it is important to develop multiple competencies that enhance student learning, such as active listening, emotional intelligence and leadership.
- **Feedback.** Constant feedback is indispensable in coaching applied to education.

Course description

Being an educator is a path that requires trust and patience. And it is easy that at some point you will encounter fatigue, a certain sense of misunderstanding or loneliness, difficult emotions or the constant search for ways to make you feel more coherent and connected to your vocation.

This educational coaching course offers you a learning space to reconnect with your vocation, provide you with tools and skills to manage your self-care, new ways of handling the classroom and managing conflicts.

Develop your role as a teacher-coach by acquiring new knowledge and tools.

How to get to Córdoba?

Córdoba has no airport, but there are excellent connections to our city from three international airports thanks to the AVE (High Speed Train):

- Madrid. 400 kilometres, 1.45 hours to Córdoba by train.
- Seville. 130 kilometres, 45 minutes to Córdoba by train.
- Málaga. 145 kilometres. 50 minutes to Córdoba by train.

Málaga is the best option, due to the high amount and variety of international destinations and the facilities to link your flight to the train.

Madrid International Airport Adolfo Suárez is the biggest airport in Spain and it has connections with all the important destinations in Europe. Flights use to be cheaper and both the frequency and the options are higher, so it is also a good chance.

Seville is another option, though destinations and frequencies are not the best. Check if it fits your plans.

Train. There are different companies offering connections from and to Madrid, Málaga and Sevilla to Córdoba. The sooner you book, the cheaper!!

- RENFE (www.renfe.es). In trains from and to Seville or Málaga, you will find AVE and AVANT. The service is the same, though this last one is cheaper. It happens the same from Madrid with AVE and ALVIA.
- IRYO. (<https://iryo.eu>). Cheap tickets if booked with months in advance.
- AVLO (<https://avlorenfe.com>). From June 1st 2023. Renfe low cost brand.

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
